

- · Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.


Care and maintenance







Assembly of the table.




Step 1.1

Screw the bolts op into the holes indicated on the legs 4 and 5.




Step 1.3

Place the legs 4 and 5 onto the sides 2 and 3.


Push cams (a) into the holes indicated on the sides (2) and (3). Arrows pointing towards the legs (4) (5).


Turn the cams (a) to the right to fix the legs (4) and (5).

Screw the bolts op into the holes indicated on the sides 2 and 3.








Knock the dowels (4) into the holes indicated on the dividers (12) using a small hammer.






Turn around the divider 12 and fix the drawer runner 1 using screws through the holes indicated.





Screw the bolts op into the holes indicated on the top 1.







Push cams (a) into the holes indicated on the dividers (12), arrows pointing towards the top (1).

Turn the cams **6** to the right to fix the dividers **12**.


Place the sides 2 and 3 onto the back rail 6 and the front rail 7.

Push cams (a) into the holes indicated on the back rail (b) and the front rail (7).

Arrows pointing towards the sides 2/3.

Place the sides 2 and 3 onto the top 1.

Turn the cams **3** to the right to fix the top **1**.







Step 1.15

Draw a line as shown using a pencil.







Step 1.16





Push dressing table up against the wall.






Fix the strap to the back rail 6 using the screw and washer provided.



Wall Mounting & Fixings



IMPORTANT:

When drilling into walls always check that there are no hidden wires or pipes etc. Make sure that the screws and wall plugs being used are suitable for supporting your unit. Consult a qualified tradesperson if you are unsure.


HINTS:

- 1) General Rule igwedge Always use a larger screw and wall plug if you are not sure.
- 2) Ensure you use the recommended drill bit to match the wall plug and hole size.
- 3) Ensure you drill the hole horizontally, do not force the drill or enlarge the hole.
- 4) Take extra care when drilling high walls, ceilings and ceramic tiles. Ensure the plug is fitting below the ceramic tile to avoid splitting or cracking.
- 5) Ensure wall plugs are well fitted and are a tight fit in the drilled hole.

Types Of Walls


You can use one of the following types of wall plug if your walls are made of brick, breeze block, concrete, stone, wood or plaster board.

No.1 "Standard" Wall Plug **General Wall Materials**



These come in various sizes and are made from plastic or sometimes wood fiber.


No.2 "General Purpose" Wall Plug Aerated / Breeze Block



Generally aerated blocks should not be used to support heavy loads, use a specialist fitting in this case.


For light loads, a General Purpose Plug can be used.

No.3 "Shield Anchor" Wall Plug **Heavy Loads**




For use with heavier loads such as TV & HiFi Speakers and Satellite Dishes etc.

No.4 "Cavity Fixing" Wall Plug




For use with plaster board partitions or hollow wooden doors.

No.5 "Cavity Fixing - Heavy Duty" Wall Plug



For use when fitting or supporting heavy loads such as shelving, wall cabinets,

No.6 "Hammer Fixing" Wall Plug



For use with walls stuck with plaster board. The hammer fixing allows it to be fixed to the wall rather than the plaster board. Always check the fixing is secure to the retaining wall.


Fix the drawer sides 9 to the drawer back 10 as shown, using screws BD.




Knock the dowels Ab into the holes indicated on the drawer sides 9 using a smal hammer.








Slide the drawer bottom 11 into the drawer sides 9.

Screw the bolts op into the holes indicated on the drawer front 8.







Make sure the angle between


the drawer front 8 and the drawer sides 9 is 90° before the drawer bottom 11 is fixed using 6 as shown.

To adjust the angle between the sides and the front push the fitting **f** sidewards.

Fix the drawer runners and to the drawer sides using screws to into the holes indicated.










Fix the metal knobs 69 to the drawer front 8 using screws 69.









