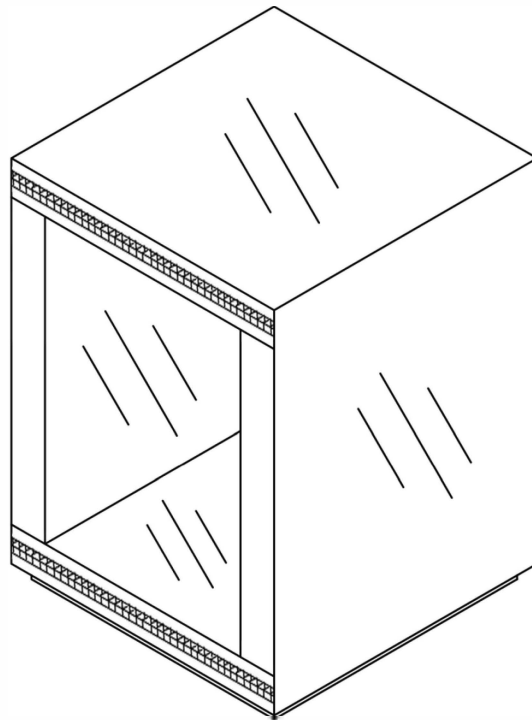


## BIARRITZ CUBE LAMP TABLE

### Important: Read carefully

- ➔ Please check you have all parts listed on your assembly sheet. In the unlikely event that any parts are missing, please contact your retailer immediately.
- ➔ Do not use any other tools than those listed on your assembly sheet / tools provided. Use of power tools could damage your product and returns would not be accepted back in these circumstances. Use of power tools could also make your product unsafe due to overtightening.
- ➔ Depending on the amount of use your product receives, it may be necessary to tighten the fixings from time to time.
- ➔ Assemble your product on a soft surface to avoid scratching and also preferably in the room intended for use to avoid having to move the product unnecessarily once assembled
- ➔ For cleaning please use a clean damp cloth or duster. Use of abrasive or chemical cleaners will most likely scratch or damage the surface of your product. We do not accept returns for damages arising from incorrect care of products
- ➔ Please keep the original packing until your item is fully assembled and in place. In the unlikely event you need to return your product. It must be returned back in its original packing to avoid any damage.
- ➔ The surface of this item is not heat resistant. Please use a mat under hot, cold or wet items to prevent marking.



# Furniture Safety and Care Advice

## Furniture Care and Cleaning

Following these few basic steps will help you enjoy and protect your investment for years to come.

### 1. Do not expose your furniture to any liquids.

- All liquids should be wiped up immediately with a soft, slightly damp cloth in the direction of the wood grain. For stone surfaces, liquids should be immediately soaked up with a paper towel and wiped dry to avoid any staining.
- Avoid harsh commercial cleaners, glass cleaners and spray polishes on wood furniture and fabric.

### 2. Do not expose your furniture to strong or direct sunlight or near heat outlets.

- Excessive exposure to sunlight and heat can cause fading of your furniture finish. Extreme temperatures and humidity changes can cause wood cracking and splitting.

### 3. Do not place rubber or plastic materials on the wood finish.

- Chemicals within the plastic or rubber may react with the finish if left in contact for a long period of time.
- Place a strip of felt or cork under your accessories to avoid any markings.

### 4. Never place hot objects on any furniture surface.

- Always place a hot plate between your furniture top and a hot object to protect your furniture.

### 5. Dust with a clean, damp, lint free cloth.

- Frequent dusting will remove a brasive build up, which can cause damage a finish over time.
- Small scratches and marks can be touched up or covered with a mark or scratch remover or a touch up stick. These can be purchased from any paint or hardware store.

### 6. Maintenance

- From time-to-time check that there are no loose screws on the furniture.

## Take Care of it Mirrored Furniture

### 1. Keep catching eyes with the sparkling impressions of your mirrored furniture by treating them with the care they need.

### 2. Mirrors are more fragile material, taking extra precautions can go a long way towards keeping them safe:

- Avoid putting these pieces in high-traffic spots, smaller areas, and spots directly next to doors that may bang into them if opened carelessly.
- To avoid scrapes, make sure the items you place on your mirrored surface are not sharp or jagged. Also avoid heavy objects that may nick or crack if lifted and set back down.
- Kids and pets? Say no more. Mirrors are fragile, so family rooms and play rooms might not be the best place for your favorite mirrored piece to live. If you can't resist, protect the surface during playtime with a soft blanket.

### 3. Clean Dust and polish routinely- Use a soft cloth with a mirror-safe glass cleaner or make a DIY solution of the distilled white vinegar and water. Quick to clean off certain household items with chemicals like nail polish remover, hair dye, lotions, perfume and cologne, and rubbing alcohol, which could damage the surface at a quicker pace.
