



Before you start...





We advise that you keep the hardware in a bowl during assembly to avoid losing anything.

Small component parts could choke a child if swallowed.

We recommend you use a sheet or blanket to protect both floor and product through the assembly stages.


This product is heavy, and we recommend a 2 person lift to avoid personal injury or damage to the product.

Never push or pull the product as this could cause both personal injury or irreparable damage to product or floor.

We have tried to make this piece of furniture easy to assemble if the instructions are followed carefully.







In the unlikely event that you have problems with assembling the product or have missing or damaged parts, please contact your retailer and we will assist them in rectifying the problem as quickly as possible.

Please remember we strongly urge you DO NOT use power tools such as drill or electric screwdrivers as this could cause irreparable damage to your product and will invalidate your warranty.










2 Before tightening the bolts, please ensure the bed frame is square.



4 Secure hydraulic arms

Before connecting the hydraulic arm, ensure the lifting mechanism is functioning correctly - it should lift up and down freely with adequate clearance on all sides.






8 Pull the belt tight after loop-on



9 Place the mattress onto the frame. (MATTRESS NOT INCLUDED)



Notes:

It is imperative that the bed is aligned squarely to prevent the frame from catching on and damaging the side rails. Please use extra caution when opening and closing the bed, ensure a similar spacing on each side of the frame.

Hints and Tips

To operate the ottoman, always use 2 hands at arm's length and only where illustration on this product. You must ensure the mattress is on the bed frame before lifting the mechanism. **Failure to do so may result in injury.**

To ensure your safety please do not stand too close in case the frame bounces up. The weight of the mattress loaded on the frame will keep the frame in a lower position until it is pulled upwards by the user.



Do not attempt to move the bed whilst the frame is in the upright position

If removing the mattress, make sure the frame is secured so it does not flip open. When lifting the bed frame, remove pillows and covers.



PLEASE NOTE - It takes a lot of force to make the initial movement of the ottoman – **THIS IS A DESIGN FEATURE OF THE PRODUCT SO THAT IT DOES NOT FALL SHUT** - and the nearer to being closed the ottoman is, the easier it is to move. When the ottoman is almost shut, it will close completely under its own weight.

When lowering the slat unit for the first time, take care to make sure it does not rub unevenly on the inside face of the Side Rail. If it does, the bed has been assembled slightly out of square. This can be rectified by moving the Footboard of the bed slightly to the left or right whilst leaving the headboard of the bed frame stationary.

Tip for difficulty with compression:

If you are experiencing difficulty with the initial compression try fitting one piston at a time (following the Assembly Instructions) then press down on the side of the frame with the piston fitted - this acts like a big lever (The weight of the mattress can be used to supplement the load exerted). Effectively you are doubling the amount of force applied, because you have halved the resistance offered by the pistons. It can take slightly more effort than you might feel comfortable applying to the bed frame at first.

Do not attempt to move the bed whilst the frame is in the upright position.



GENERAL CARE & MAINTENANCE

We advise that when cleaning the product that a damp cloth is used.

Avoid the use of all household cleaners and abrasive.

Never push or drag the furniture.

Never attempt to move the furniture when fully loaded.

We advise that periodically all fixing are re-tightened.
