

TIPS & IMPORTANT SAFETY

Top Tips before you start!

- 1. Please check that all parts are present before you start the assembly of your furniture, as once assembled, the furniture CANNOT be returned.
- 2. For ease and speed of assembly, we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly, that you identify all the parts required for that step.
- 3. We recommend that, where possible, all items are assembled near to the area in which they will be placed in use, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.
- 4. For the protection of your furniture, particularly items of high gloss finish, we recommend that the product is placed on a protected surface during assembly to prevent any damage.
- 5. During assembly please take care not to over-tighten any fittings, as this may damage the product.

SAFETY

- 1. This product is heavy, take extreme care when lifting to avoid personal injury or damage to the product.
- 2. Choking hazard keep small components away from young children. We recommend children are kept well away from the assembly area.



WARNING & RECOMMENDATIONS

WARNING

- 1. Use this product for its specified purpose and function only.
- 2. If parts are missing, broken, damaged or worn, stop using this product until you have repaired it fully.
- 3. Make sure this product is placed on a flat level surface and is stable before use. This product must make full contact with the surface before use.
- 4. This product is heavy. Use an assistant when lifting.




RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Please take the time to carefully read through the whole of these instructions before you commence with assembly.
- 2. Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- 3. Wipe occasionally with a soft cloth dampened with water. Then buff with a dry clean soft cloth.
- 4. Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. Absorption can cause wood to warp or finishes to de-laminated.
- 5. Please check that the centre support rail is securely fixed in place.
- 6. Keep these instructions for future reference.




